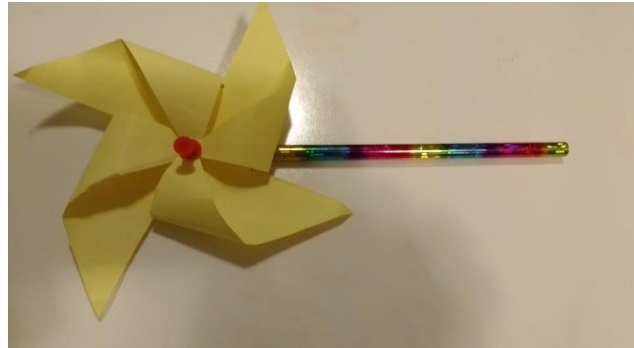


How to Make a Tiny Pinwheel



Materials:

- Paper that is coloured, double sided or printed on, your choice
- Small pony bead
- Pencil
- Push pin tack
- Scissors
- Ruler

Method:

- ✓ Cut a 11cm X 11cm piece out of the paper
- ✓ Fold paper in half corner to corner so a triangle is formed.
- ✓ Open out the paper flat and fold over as before. Open it out flat again. The square is now divided into four triangular sections.
- ✓ Starting from the centre make a mark 3cm down on each folded line.
- ✓ Carefully cut starting at each corner and along the folded line to the mark you just made.
- ✓ Hold the bottom left corner of one section and bend towards the centre. Do not fold.
- ✓ Repeat for other three sections holding them together at the ends over the centre of the paper where the folded lines cross.
- ✓ Push the pin through the ends of the corners you are holding and through the centre of the paper making a pinwheel.
- ✓ Put the pony bead onto the pin at the back of the pinwheel.
- ✓ Push the pin into the wood just below the eraser of the pencil.
- ✓ Blow and watch it spin!
