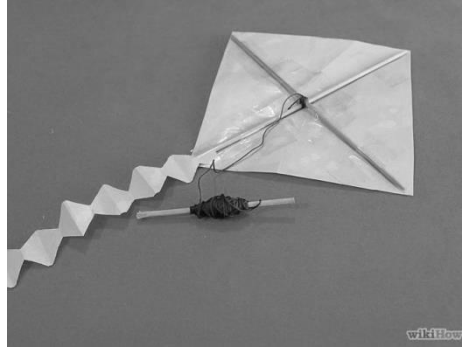


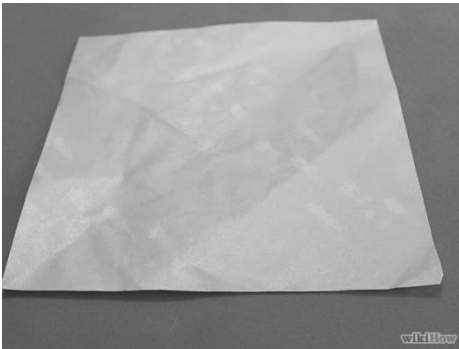
How to Make a Tiny Kite



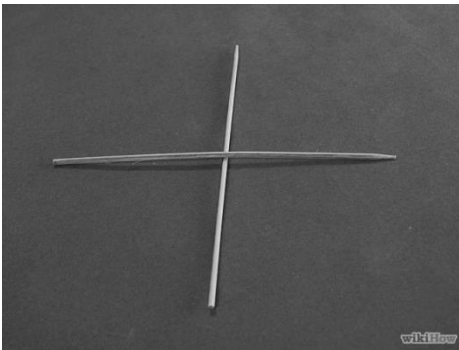
Materials:

- Lightweight paper like parchment paper
- Three wooden skewers
- Yarn
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Transparent tape

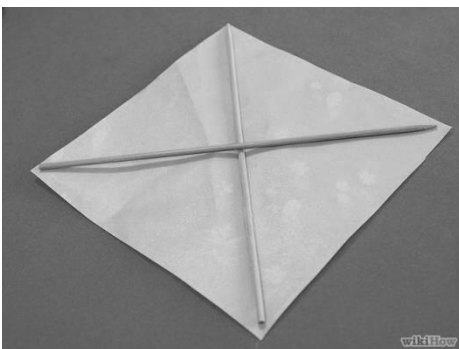
Method:



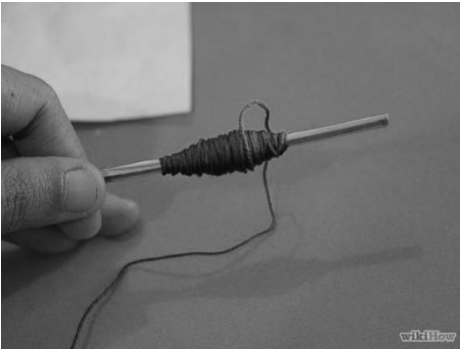
1. Cut the paper into a square



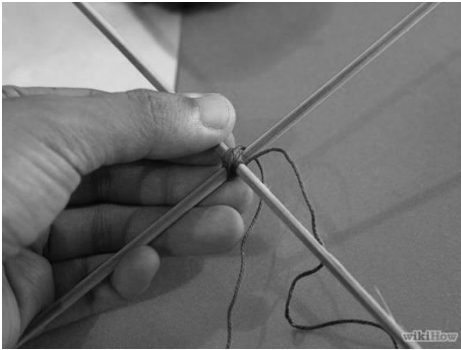
2. Lay out the skewers so they make a cross or a "t".



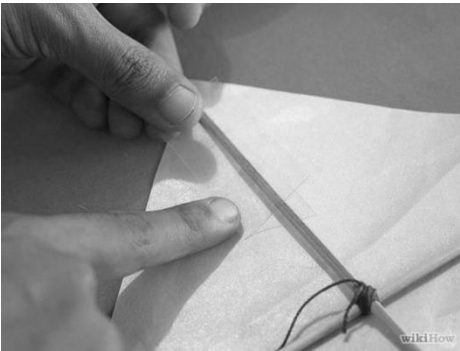
3. Cut the skewers so that each skewer fits into each corner.



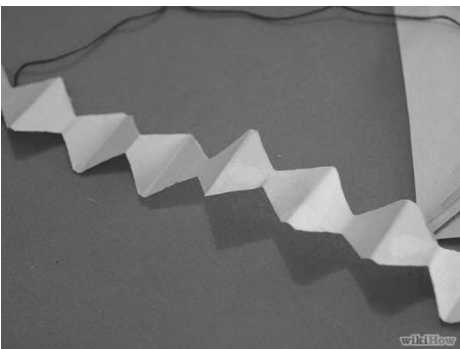
4. Take out the stick and yarn. Tie yarn to the centre of the stick and wrap around.



5. Hold the skewers together in the middle and wrap loose end of the yarn around the intersections of your skewers.



6. Glue or tape your skewers to the paper.



7. Make the tail by taking a strip of paper. Fold it accordion style and Cut into a triangle being sure not to leave an uncut strip at the top and bottom. Glue or tape one end to bottom corner edge of the kite
