

Sand and Seashell Pendant or Camp Hat Craft

Materials:

- Sand (available at craft stores in different colours and textures)
- Tiny seashell or pebble
- Modge Podge (available at craft stores)
- Bottle cap (can be purchased at grocery and wine/beer making stores)
- Short piece of thin wire
- Hammer and small nail
- Pencil
- Masking tape
- Popsicle stick
- For necklace: cord, about 20"
- For camp hat: safety pin

Method:

- ✓ Using hammer and nail make a small hole in the flat part of the bottle cap near one edge. This will be where the wire goes through.
- ✓ Bend the wire around the pencil making a loop and twist ends several times. Put the ends of the wire through the hole you just made and spread out over the bottom of the bottle cap. Use a small piece of masking tape to hold in place.
- ✓ Mix a small amount of Modge Podge and sand together with the popsicle stick. Using the popsicle stick press the mixture into the bottle cap filling it and making sure the loop faces up and the ends of the wire are well covered. When the Modge Podge dries the wire will stay in place.
- ✓ Place the tiny seashell or rock in the centre of the sand mixture before it is dry. Use a small amount of Modge Podge to hold in place if needed. Let dry.

For necklace;

- ✓ Fold cord in half and push folded end through the loop. Put long ends of cord through the fold and pull tight.
- ✓ Tie a knot in the ends of the cord to make the necklace.

For Camp Hat:

- ✓ Open safety pin and put through loop.
- ✓ Wear with pride
